Naming of new Phillips Creek Bridge

Cr Rachel Anderson asked if Council will be naming the new Phillips Creek Bridge once finalised and if so, what is the process for this to occur.

Twin Hills 100th Anniversary Event 2025

Cr Rachel Anderson asked if Council is expected to provide additional budget for the Twin Hills area for road maintenance etc in preparation for the celebration of the Twin Hills 100th anniversary next year.

The Manager Infrastructure advised that no additional budget has been considered or requested outside of the normal road maintenance in this area.

Peak Downs Mine Access Road Safety Concerns

Cr Alaina Earl advised that she has received many complaints about the current roadworks on the Peak Downs Mine Access Road – the current works is dangerous and has no signage.

Intersections - Goonyella Road

Cr Alaina Earl asked for an update on her Councillor Question from the October Standing Committee meeting:

Receiving various complaints from community and industry representatives regarding Goonyella Road Intersections:

- 1. There is a large dip at the intersection of Thorpe Street and Goonyella Road, Moranbah. Can you please advise if there is a maintenance plan to fix this large dip.
- 2. Safety concerns have been raised about the intersection of Colliery Street, Industrial Avenue and Goonyella Road near the BP Service Station. Can there be improvements on this intersection for lighting and signage (including line marking)?

Cr Viv Coleman asked if the drains on the Majors Road Crossing at Carmila West can be inspected and cleaned out ahead of this year's wet season.

6.7 Missing Signage - Sarina-Marlborough Road and Connors River Road

Cr Viv Coleman asked if Council could contact TMR regarding the missing signage on the Intersection of the Sarina-Marlborough Road and Connors River Road.

6.8 Abandoned Vehicles on Isaac Region Roads

Cr Viv Coleman asked if we could please do something about the large number of abandoned vehicles in the Isaac Region. It is starting to look very untidy.

6.9 Formal Access to the Notch Point Road Reserve

Cr Viv Coleman asked if we have formalised access to the Notch Point Road Reserve that will allow Council to have a dedicated access point through this area.

6.10 Big Dip on Peak Downs Highway

Cr Melissa Westcott asked for an update on the Councillor Question raised at the September 2024 Standing Committee Meeting:

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BP Peak Downs Highway - Cr Melissa Westcott enquired about when repair/maintenance works for the below road issues will occur:

The big dip near the BP Service Station on the Peak Downs Highway - timeline for when this is to be repaired – Response: in a current tender package which is about to be awarded.

CCTV PILOT PROGRAM 6.11

Cr Melissa Westcott asked if there is a possibility that the CCTV Pilot Program being shortened to ensure that we can add CCTV coverage into the budget process for the 2025/2026 financial year to assist with eliminating vandalism in our parks and facilities.

6.12 Town Square Gardens and Large Trees

Cr Melissa Westcott enquired regarding the Town Square Gardens and Large Trees as she has been receiving feedback from shop owners regarding the following:

- New gardens consideration of some of the planting (i.e. Golden Cane Palms) having an impact on the footpath (crowding and damage to concrete).
- Large trees has Council considered reducing the number of large trees that cause large volume of leaves that requires regular daily clean up and increases the number of birds that causes bird droppings in seating areas.

6.13 Wide Load Approvals

Cr Melissa Westcott asked if Council plays apart in the Wide Load Escorts and the distance between the Wide Load and the Escort Vehicles - sometimes the escort vehicles and very close to the wide load which is preventing adequate time for vehicles to pull up safely in a safe area.

The Director Engineering and Infrastructure advised that this is the responsibility of the truck driver, police and wide load escort companies. This would be best taken to the Road Safety Action Group for consideration.
